Requirements:

- Must be 21 years old.
- Must hold current Camp Directors Certification from National Camping School of the Boy Scouts of America
- Must be able to lift and carry 30lbs.
- Must be able to stand and/or walk long hours every day.
- Participates in pre-camp meetings and staff training week.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America
- Must be willing to provide year round assistance in planning, creating, and promotion of camp programs.

Responsibilities:

- Reports to Scout Executive.
- Manages the operation of the camp and maintains a constant concern for the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment of the campers who visit the camp.
- See that standards for leadership and program activities are maintained.
- Assumes the direction of overall program of the camp.
- Works with Program Director to assure that all program areas are providing quality program including camp-wide campfire programs that build enthusiasm and Scout spirit with the camp staff and resident campers
- Evaluate the program effectiveness and implement changes to meet the needs of the camp.
- Assumes recruitment and hiring of a qualified Camp Staff.
- Provide leadership with the Program Director for the camp staff to see that the established camp program is executed.
- Foster an environment of teamwork, by implementing regular team building, and morale building activities.
- Assumes the direction to implement and adhere to the staff mission statement.
- The Camp Director shall correct and discipline any member of the staff; they shall keep accurate records of any such incident.
- As a Camp Director, do their part for the character building process in scouting and constantly be aware of the example they are setting for the campers.
- At the end of the camping season, submit a completed report to Scout Executive of all program activities.
- Maintain financial accounting record of all expenses during camp.
- Assume all other duties as assigned by the Scout Executive.
