**Requirements:**

- Must be 21 years old.
- Must be able to lift and carry 50lbs.
- Must be able to stand and/or walk long hours every day.
- Participates in pre-camp meetings and staff training week.
- Have earned, or hold the equivalent of, the Merit Badges in their area responsibility.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America

**Responsibilities:**

- Reports to Program Director.
- Serves as the Supervisor and Staff Leader of the ATV Instructors.
- Assume responsibility for the training of ATV Staff and coordinating their work.
- Know how all ATV activities fit into the advancement program of the Boy Scouts of America and be familiar with these requirements, make all ATV activities available to Scouts.
- Maintain all equipment in good repair. Report any damaged or broken equipment to the Program Director. Maintain a current inventory.
- Deliver the advertised programming from the camp leader/program guide in a safe, efficient, and high quality manner.
- Work in conjunction with the council ATV committee to develop and execute site specific policies, procedures, and programming.
- Meet with the Program Director periodically to evaluate the ATV program quality.
- At the end of the season, submit a complete report and inventory to the Program Director.
- Develop a thorough knowledge of their particular subject area.
- Develop a complete set of notes, visual aids and reference materials as needed to effectively teach.
- Assist Scouts in obtaining the maximum benefit from the ATV area.
- Participate and assist in all patrol activities and camp wide activities as assigned.
- As a staff member, do their part for the character building process in scouting and constantly be aware of the example they are setting for the campers.
- Perform all other duties as assigned by the Program Director, Camp Director.
