Requirements:

- Must be 18 years old.
- Must be able to lift and carry 50lbs.
- Must be able to stand and/or walk long hours every day.
- Participates in pre-camp meetings and staff training week.
- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America
- Must hold current certification to meet the minimum standards established by the BSA.

Responsibilities:

- As a staff member, do their part for the character building process in scouting and constantly be aware of the example they are setting for the campers.
- Maintain residence in the Health Lodge and be available 24 hours a day.
- Maintain a regular and posted hours of medication dispersal.
- Coordinate with designated Scout Leaders to disperse medications in campsites.
- Administer medical rechecks at check-in times.
- Maintain required records related to the Health Lodge accurately, completely, and organized in such a way as to be easily accessible when needed. This includes the Camp First Aid Log, in which every person treated must be logged in, and must maintain all individuals Health and Medical records.
- Notify the Camp Director immediately of any serious injury, illness, or death. Know the proper procedures to be followed in such cases.
- Maintain the Health Lodge and facilities in a neat, clean, and orderly condition. Keep medications shelved and grouped. Keep dangerous drugs under lock and key.
- Assist Scouts in obtaining the maximum benefit from program offered.
- Participate and assist in all camp activities and duties as assigned.
- Do your part to adhere to the camp staff mission statement and vision of camp.
- Do your part to prevent waste and abuse of camp property.
- As a staff member, do their part for the character building process in scouting and constantly be aware of the example they are setting for the campers.
- Assume all other duties as assigned by the Camp Director.
