Dear Scout Leader,

The 2023 Scouts BSA summer camp reservations process is now open! Each unit will be able to submit a one-time, non-refundable deposit of \$100 to register as a unit and choose their patrol site(s) for the upcoming year. The reservation fee is a flat \$100 deposit per unit, regardless of the number of patrol sites you request.

- 1) Any Scout unit with a 2022 reservation will have "first choice" on the same session, campsite and patrol site(s) for 2023 through August 26th, 2022.
- 2) After August 26th all remaining 2023 campsites and patrol site(s) by session will be open for reservations on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 3) Troops may reserve only the campsite(s) and patrol site(s) they can reasonably fill (youth and adults attending camp), final determination will be made by the council.
- 4) Reservations will only be held by completing a 2023 Summer Camp Reservation form and submitting appropriate fees.
- 5) Each reservation requires a \$100 deposit that will be used as a credit to your summer camp account statement.
- 6) The council will resolve and make final determination on any campsite reservation disputes through the council camping committee.

Example: Troop 007 is signed up to attend Boy Scout summer camp in 2022, session 2 and they have Patrol site(s) A & B in Winnebago campsite. Troop 007 has "dibs" to hold that same reservation for 2023 as long as they complete the 2023 Summer Camp Reservation form and submit the deposit by August 26th, 2022. If Troop 007 does not do this, then session 2, Winnebago campsite, patrol sites A & B will be available for another troop to reserve.
