We are searching for outgoing individuals, who have a passion for leading youth through an incredible youth leadership training program in an outdoor setting! Summer camp lasts from early June through late July, and our staff truly becomes a second family.

Objective: The OA Camp Representative will promote, coordinate, and implement all OA activities at Camp Chief Little Turtle throughout the summer. He will work with the Lodge Adviser, Lodge Staff Adviser, Camp Program Director, and Camp Director to ensure that all troops represented at summer camp have an opportunity to be active and involved with OA activities.

Responsibilities:

- Will be appointed by the Lodge Chief with the approval of the Lodge Adviser and Camp Director. He will be less than 21 years of age for the entire duration of the appointed term, a registered member of the BSA and a dues paying member of the lodge
- Must be at least a Brotherhood member or above
- Will meet with all in-council and out-of-council troops to promote OA involvement and welcome them on behalf of the lodge
- Will identify if each troop is familiar or involved with OA in their unit and lodge
- If troops are not familiar or involved with the OA, he will give the scouts and leaders an orientation to the OA program
- Should encourage troops to hold elections in their unit and become involved
- Confirm if all dues are paid or not paid by members and encourage them to be current in paying their dues
- Coordinate and teach, if necessary, the Brotherhood class if there are any members eligible
- Promote and coordinate the Brotherhood and Rededication Ceremonies with the Ceremonies Chairman and Adult Adviser.
- Encourage all Brotherhood and Vigil members to attend the Brotherhood Ceremony
- Encourage all OA members to attend the OA Rededication Ceremony
- Record and collect dues and fees from Brotherhood candidates that are going through the class. Keep a list for the Lodge Membership Chairman and /or Adviser.
- Promote attendance for the Fall Ordeal especially if the Ordeal Candidate did not attend the Spring Ordeal
- Promote attendance at the Fall Fellowship
- Coordinate and arrange Service Projects for troops or individuals that need to complete one with the Camp Ranger
- Coordinate the Call-Out Ceremony. Help enlist a ceremony team to provide the call-out
