Position: **Shooting Sports Director**

Summer camp lasts from early June through late July, and our staff truly becomes a second family.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 21 years of age.
- Must be able to lift and carry 30lbs.
- Must be able to stand and/or walk long hours every day.
- Participates in pre-camp meetings and staff training week.
- Must hold current Shooting Sports Certification from National Camping School of the Boy Scouts of America.
- Hold, or have earned the equivalent of, the Merit Badge in their areas of responsibility.
- Must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America.

Responsibilities:

- Reports to Program Director.
- Serves as the supervisor and staff leader of the Shooting Sports Staff.
- Assumes responsibility for training the Shooting Sports Staff and coordinating their work.
- Assist is developing a lesson plan and summer syllabus. Make approved changes to meet the needs of the participants.
- Know how all Shooting Sports activities fit into the advancement program of the Boy Scouts of America and be familiar with these requirements. Make all Shooting Sports activities available to Scouts.
- Deliver the advertised programming from the camp leader/program guide in a safe, efficient, and high quality manner.
- Work in conjunction with council Shooting Sports Committee to develop and execute site specific policies, procedures, and programming.
- Supervision of the firing lines whenever someone is shooting on any of the ranges.
- Properly store and maintain all Shooting Sports equipment in good repair. Maintain a current inventory. Report any damaged, broken, or unsafe equipment to the Program Director.
- Meet with the Program Director periodically to evaluate the Shooting Sports program quality.
- At the end of the season, submit a complete report and inventory to the Program Director.
- Assume all other duties as assigned by the Program Director, Camp Director.
